



Promoting and validating key competences in Mobility and Traineeships in Europe

Aim

- promoting and validating social, personal and organisational key competences (entrepreneurship, civic competences and learning to learn)

Approach

- innovative, self-directed learning approach
- at the interface of higher education and business (knowledge alliance)
- traineeships for students in businesses or enterprises
- learning projects



Main outputs

- Validation system for the key competences: KC6: social and civic competences, KC7: sense of initiative and entrepreneurship and KC5: learning to learn
- Competence oriented learning approach that considers the needs, the contexts and the environment of the learners.
- Training and counselling units for educational personnel to enable them to apply the holistic PROMOTE methodology in their organisation and use it for planning and implementing support measures for informal learning.
- Pilots: accompanied traineeships
- Validation: ca. 140 students will acquire a set of defined key competences and will be validated along the PROMOTE procedure.
